ten years are nothing*

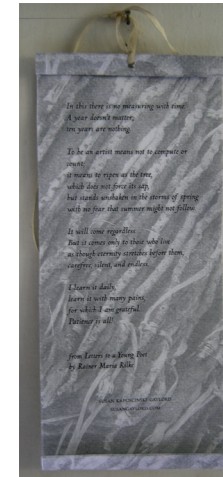
*To be an artist means not to compute or

TO MAKE THE SCROLL:

Cut out the front and back and
glue the blank sides together.

From the top, fold down a tab
about 1/4" wide. Fold the tab
over again.

Do the same at the bottom.

Poke a hole in the center of the top folds with the pointy
end of a pair of scissors, an awl, or a needle.

Thread a piece of thread or string about 12" (or twice
the height of the scroll) long through the hole.

Pull the ends of the thread to make them even.

Tie a knot on top of the fold.

Tie a double knot about a 1/2" (pinky-width) up from the
first knot. This will make a loop that you can use to hang
the scroll.

To store the scroll: Roll up the scroll from the bottom.
Tie the two ends around the rolled scroll. Untie to read
or hang.
